"NCCS approval of the Blessed are the Merciful activity was granted on April 27, 2014 by the NCCS Executive Board, the same day that both Pope John XXIII and Pope John Paul II were declared saints. Pope John XXIII is best remembered for his historic encyclical "Pacem in Terris," and for his calling of the Second Vatican Council. He promoted Peace on Earth and by convening

the Second Vatican Council helped open the Church to the modern world. Pope John Paul II is most remembered for his charismatic nature, his love of youth and his world travels, along with his role in the fall of communism in Europe during his 27-year papacy. He established the Sunday after Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday and encouraged the praying of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy."

Scouts should perform an act of mercy. The Corporal Works of Mercy are the kind of acts by which we help our neighbors with their material and physical needs. These acts are: Feed the hungry; Shelter the homeless; Clothe the naked; Visit the sick and imprisoned; Bury the dead, and Give alms to the poor.
